

NEXTCHEM AND SUEZ SIGN AN AGREEMENT TO DEVELOP THEIR COLLABORATION ON WASTE-TO-CHEMICALS TECHNOLOGY AND PROJECTS IN ITALY

Milan, 9 November 2022 – Maire Tecnimont S.p.A. announces that NextChem, through its subsidiary MyRechemical, has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with SUEZ International Italian Branch aimed at further developing their existing collaboration on Waste-to-Chemicals projects in Italy. The agreement was signed during Ecomondo, the key event in Europe for technological and industrial innovation in the green and circular economy sectors, within the framework of the NextGenerationEU.
